

Category: Attractions

Attractions are places that help a tourist make their travel planning decision(s) and are typically places a tourist will travel to see or experience. These places of interest should have cultural value, historical significance, natural beauty, adventure/leisure offerings or simply provide amusement to the tourist while vacationing.

In addition to the information outlined above, businesses in this category will be allowed to display the following information:

Amusement Parks & Centers

This subcategory includes:

- Theme parks offering a variety of activities, such as rides or waterparks.
- A park offering activities such as rope courses, zip lines or canopy tours.
- Establishments that offer go-kart rides.

Art Galleries & Studios

This subcategory includes:

- Attractions showcasing art such as paintings, sculptures, etc.
- Attractions that offer visitors the opportunity to purchase art work.
- Businesses that are predominately photo studios, frame shops and museum gift shops will not be listed.

Historic Attractions

This subcategory includes:

- Areas that offer visitors historical experiences (example: areas where historical interpreters and actors re-create life).
- This will include properties that are designated historical sites, historic buildings, historical parks, battlefields and monuments.
- Museums that primarily focus on history.

Miniature Golf & Bowling

This subcategory includes:

- Properties offering a novelty golf game played with a putter on a miniature course, usually with various obstacles at each hole.
- Properties that offer bowling as a stand-alone activity.

Museums

This subcategory includes:

- Attractions that house artifacts in a museum-style setting.
- Museums dedicated to telling the story of America's heritage and history.
- Historical and genealogical societies are included if they are open on a seasonal or year-round basis, have regular hours of operation and offer tours or demonstrations.

Parks, Beaches & Trails

This subcategory:

- Must be an actual state, national park or wildlife refuge.
- Must be a marked trail or provide guided or self-guided tours.
- Must be open to the public and allow activities such as swimming, hiking, biking etc.

Plantations

This subcategory includes:

- Large historic estates that offer guided or self-guided tours.

Spas

This subcategory includes:

- Standalone spas and properties that include spas, such as hotels.
- Establishments that take appointments or walk-ins for treatments such as manicures, pedicures, facials and massages.

Theater

This subcategory includes:

- Attractions that offer some type of theatrical production or performing arts.
- Establishments that have a regular season of performances (seasonal or year-round).
- Establishments that offer musical performances such as symphonies and performing art centers.
- Theater companies without a physical address and dedicated performance space will not be listed, but can submit events.
- Movie theaters and stadiums that host concerts and sporting venues will not be listed.

Tours

This subcategory includes:

- Businesses that provides the public with a short trip through a place or to view something.
- Tours may have guides or be self guided.

Wineries, Breweries & Distilleries

This subcategory includes:

- Breweries and wineries that are open seasonally or year-round and offer tastings, tours and events.
- Breweries and brewpubs that sell beer manufactured on site, as opposed to a pub that offers a collection of imported beers.
- Wineries that sell wine made on site, as opposed to a pub that offers a collection of imported wines.
